Born To Be Wild

– classic Rock meets Barbershop! recorded by *Lions Gate Chorus*

(The) Boys in the Bright White Sports Car (Trooper)

– fun rhythmic arrangement, 70's pop song

Canadian Medley

– medley of Canadian folk favourites

– recorded by *North Metro Chorus*

Car Wash (from "Shark Tales")

– 70's dance hit, very fun and rhythmic, very difficult

– great opener – recorded by *the BUZZ*

– from Walt Disney Pictures' "Hercules"

Guess Who I Saw Today (from "New Faces of 1952")

– recorded by *Brava!*

Happy Birthday (Doo-Wop)

– fun to sing version of the "Birthday standard"

Happy Rhythm

– Mosie Lister song, bright gospel swing

Heat Wave (a.k.a. Love Is Like A Heat Wave)

– chorus arrangement, recorded by *Lions Gate Chorus*. Hot!

Hero (Mariah Carey)

– inspirational ballad, for chorus and solo

– recorded by *Westcoast Harmony Chorus*

Holding Out For A Hero (from "Footloose" and "Shrek II")

– recorded by *Westcoast Harmony Chorus*

Home To Stay

– beautiful Josh Groban ballad; for chorus/solo

I Believe I Can Fly

– 90's pop hit by R Kelly; for chorus/solo

I Can Cook Too - comedy/novelty song

– caution lights: double-entendre lyrics! – recorded by *Unplugged*

I Love A Piano/Piano Roll Blues Medley

– contestable swing/uptune, difficult

If I Were A Bell (from "Guys and Dolls")	– VERY fun and very challenging!
It's A Million To One You're In Love	– contestable uptune
It's The Girl (Boswell Sisters)	– contestable uptune, recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
It's Your Song (Garth Brooks)	– for chorus and solo – recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
Jingle Bell Rock	– Christmas (secular)
Juke Box Saturday Night	– great 40's swing
(The) Longest Time (Billy Joel)	– available for chorus with solo, or four voices
Looking Through the Eyes of Love (from "Ice Castles")	– for chorus w/solo or small ensemble – recorded (in Swedish!) by <i>Stockholm City Voices</i>
(A) Lot of Livin' To Do	– very fun uptune, non-contest; recorded by <i>the BUZZ</i>
Love Never Fails	– based on JS Bach's Aria from the Orchestral Suite No. 3 in D Major
Macavity: the Mystery Cat (from "Cats")	– for chorus and solo(s), very difficult
Mary's Little Boy Child	– easy "quick learn" at Christmas! – recorded by <i>Rhythm of the Rockies Chorus</i>
My Romance	– contestable ballad, recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
My Way (yep, Sinatra)	– with some slightly more "upward trend" lyrics!
Optimistic Voices (from "The Wizard of Oz")	– NOT just a cute, fluffy song! Powerful lyrics! – recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
Picnic (McGuire Sisters)	– top melody SSAA
Return to Pooh Corner (Kenny Loggins)	– pop tempo ballad, recorded by <i>Four Bettys</i>
(The) River (Garth Brooks)	– for chorus with solo, recently re-cleared!
Sara Lee (Liza Minnelli)	– funny novelty song about – you guessed it! Sara Lee desserts!
Seasons of Love (from the musical "Rent")	– yep, it's back, recently re-cleared! – great message – recorded by <i>Lions Gate Chorus</i>
Send In The Clowns (from "A Little Night Music")	– recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
Since You've Been Gone ("Weird Al" Yankovic)	– doo-wop style - recorded by <i>Brava!</i>
Sing Sing	– Serena Ryder a cappella happy message, fun rhythmic song
Some People (from "Gypsy!")	– driving uptune with a kick-butt message
Somewhere Out There (from "An American Tail")	– beautiful ballad, for chorus with layers
Stars Fell On Alabama	– top melody 40's style SSAA
Swingin' Shepherd Blues	– it swings! 50's pop song, includes a bass feature and jazz-like scat effect
Take a Chance on Me (ABBA)	– Yes! finally back in circulation! Gotta Love ABBA! – available in four parts, or more complex layered version
Tangerine	– 40's Latin vibe
(The) Teddy Bears' Picnic	– 40's pop song "If you go down in the woods today..."
Themes of 007	– chorus medley includes The James Bond Theme, Goldfinger, Thunderball, Live And Let Die, Nobody Does It Better - with solos and layered parts
Time In A Bottle (Jim Croce)	– hauntingly beautiful 70's pop hit
To Make You Feel My Love	– beautiful ballad by Bob Dylan
Too Darn Hot	– for chorus with a solo segment, available in 4 voices – recorded by <i>Sunlight Chorus</i>
Top of the World (The Carpenters)	– 70's pop hit, happy lyrics!

We're Here For a Good Time (Not a Long Time)	– 70's pop hit from Trooper
What A Wonderful World (from "Good Morning Vietnam")	– Louis Armstrong's great hit song, recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
What Are You Doing New Year's Eve?	– lovely 40s swing tune, re-popularized by Karen Carpenter – 40s style harmony, recorded by <i>Lions Gate Chorus</i>
(A) Whole New World (from "Aladdin")	
Wimoweh (The Lion Sleeps Tonight)	– recorded by <i>Lions Gate Chorus</i>
Y.M.C.A. (70's hit by The Village People)	– rhythmic fun in complex vocal layers

You Raise Me Up (Josh Groban)	– chorus arrangement with alto-range solo

Here and Now (Matt Munro)	– snappy, jazzy opener, great lyrics – recorded by <i>the BUZZ</i> and <i>Melodeers Chorus</i>
Hey Mister! Stay!	– contestable swing uptune – recorded by <i>the BUZZ</i>
Hip To Be Square	– Huey Lewis tune, fun! (also available in YWIH voicing)
I'll Tell My Ma When I Go Home	– Irish children's street song – recorded by <i>Canadian Showtime Chorus</i> , performed by <i>North Metro Chorus</i> , International Chorus Finals Honolulu 2008
I May Wander	– beautiful ballad by Australian composer Lucy Jones
I Wonder As I Wander	– Christmas (non-secular)
La Vie en Rose	– sweet little late-40s tune - recorded by <i>Brava!</i>
Le Canon	– based on J Pachelbel's Canon in D, **NEW** now available in men's voicing

Magic Tonight!	– opener, short and snappy
Mandarin Oranges	– Christmas novelty song by Canadian composer R. McLean Wiest
O Canada	– one-pager; easy learn for Canada Day!
Old-Fashioned Rag	– contestable uptune, lots of fun
Playing The Clown	– contestable ballad, composed by barbershopper Einar Pedersen
Song for Irene	– short song of friendship, easy learn
Standing Outside The Fire (Garth Brooks)	– chorus arrangement, recorded by <i>Westcoast Harmony Chorus</i>
(The) Time Warp (from “The Rocky Horror Picture Show”)	– “It’s just a jump to the left!” recorded by <i>Lions Gate Chorus</i>
Where The Heck Is Dixie?	– contestable uptune (arrangement also available for men’s voices)
(The) Winner’s Circle	– Regional “Chorus of Quartet Champions” song
You Planted A Rose (In The Garden Of Love)	– contestable ballad
